ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS
ATTORNEY

OCTOBER 22, 2021

On October 21, 2021, Student's attorneys in this case filed a notice of motion to withdraw as attorneys for Student in this matter.

An attorney may withdraw as the attorney in a case by giving written notice to the Office of Administrative Hearings, called OAH, and all parties of the withdrawal. The written notice must include the last known address of the formerly represented party. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1015, subd. (b).) A written motion is not required.

After the withdrawal, OAH retains jurisdiction over the case, and the person bringing the claim is responsible for preparation and representation for the remainder

of the case. That person must also notify OAH if their address changes for purposes of receiving notices in the case. (*Ibid.*)

Here, Student's attorneys have filed the requisite notice, in the form of a motion, which includes the address of Student and Parent, and served a copy on Parent and Antelope Valley Union High School District. This fulfills the requirements to withdraw.

ORDER

1. The motion to withdraw is granted. Adam Wasserman and the Education Justice Law Group APC no longer represent Student in this due process matter.
2. Student is now self-represented, without an attorney of record. Student is a child under the age of 18 years, so Parent may appear and file documents for Student.
3. OAH and Antelope Valley Union High School District will serve all further documents and notices for Student to Parent.
4. Student is responsible from this point forward for his own preparation and representation at the prehearing conference, due process hearing, and any other matters brought before OAH in this matter. Student must notify OAH of any address change for receipt of notices.
