AMENDED COMPLAINT

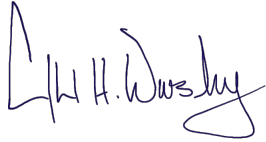

On October 18, 2021, the Office of Administrative Hearing, called OAH, issued an Order Determining Issues Two, Three, and Four of Student's Amended Due Process Complaint to be Insufficient. (20 U.S.C. § 1415(b)(7)(A)(ii)(III) & (IV).) Student was given 14 days after the Order's issuance to file an amended complaint that addressed the insufficiencies found in the Order. (20 U.S.C. § 1415(c)(2)(E)(i)(II).) On October 29, 2021, Student timely filed a second amended complaint.

Student's second amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this order. The filing of the second amended complaint restarted the applicable timelines

for the due process hearing. All applicable timelines shall be reset as of the date of this order. OAH will issue a scheduling order with the new dates.
