AMENDED ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR
VIDEOCONFERENCE MEDIATION AND CONTINUANCE OF
DUE PROCESS HEARING

This Amended order revises the Office of Administrative Hearings' previous December 2, 2022 Order Granting Request for Videoconference Mediation and Continuance of Due Process Hearing. OAH does not schedule due process hearings to start the Tuesday after a Monday holiday. To address the February 21, 2022 Washington's Birthday state holiday, this order reschedules the due process hearing in this matter to start on February 23, 2022, but makes no other changes to the previous order.

MEDIATION DATE is January 6, 2022, 1:30 PM to 5:00 PM.

MEDIATION will occur via telephone or video.

PREHEARING CONFERENCE will be held on February 11, 2022 at 3:00PM.

DUE PROCESS HEARING will be held on February 23 and 24, 2022.

PARTICIPANT INFORMATION SHEETS FOR MEDIATION AND PREHEARING CONFERENCES MUST BE FILED TWO BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THE SCHEDULED EVENT.

The hearing shall begin at 9:30 AM on all days unless otherwise ordered. The hearing shall continue day to day, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge. Prehearing conference statements and motions are due to OAH no later than three business days before the prehearing conference or with a showing of good cause why it was not timely filed.
