ORDER FOR STUDENT'S COUNSEL TO FILE ELECTRONIC
COPIES OF STUDENT'S EXHIBITS

JANUARY 10, 2022

On June 3, 2021, Parents on behalf of Student filed with the Office of Administrative Hearings, called OAH, a Due Process Hearing Request naming Lancaster School District. On November 23, 2021, OAH continued the matter for a fifth time based on the parties' joint request to continue the due process hearing to allow the parties additional time to negotiate a settlement. OAH ordered the parties to file electronic copies of their exhibits with OAH no later than 5:00 PM on January 11, 2022.

On January 10, 2022, Student's counsels, Disability Rights Legal Center and Davis Wright Tremaine LLP, filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Counsel, indicating counsels'

immediate withdrawal from representing Student and Parents, and that Parents were now representing Student in this matter.

Due to the late timing of the Notice to Withdrawal of Counsel and to ensure the orderly presentation of Student's case, Disability Rights Legal Center and Davis Wright Tremaine LLP shall file electronic copies of Student's exhibits no later than 5:00 PM on January 11, 2022, in accordance with the Order Setting Procedures for Filing Exhibits Electronically.
