ORDER RESPONDING TO SACRAMENTO CITY UNIFIED
SCHOOL DISTRICT'S REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION

JANUARY 4, 2022

On October 4, 2021, Parent on behalf of Student filed a request for due process hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, called OAH, naming Sacramento City Unified School District and Rosemont High School as respondents.

On November 19, 2021, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge held a prehearing videoconference. Parent appeared on behalf of Student. Kaitlyn Tucker and Jennifer Baldassari, Attorneys at Law, appeared on behalf of Rosemont High School and Sacramento City Unified School District.

Following the prehearing videoconference, OAH issued an order scheduling mediation and continuing the due process hearing, and order dismissing Rosemont

High School as a party. The prehearing videoconference was continued to February 4, 2022, and the due process hearing was continued to February 15, 16 and 17, 2022.

On January 4, 2022, Sacramento City Unified School District filed a request for clarification regarding the issues to be considered at the due process hearing. The issues to be determined at the due process hearing shall be discussed at the continued prehearing videoconference on February 4, 2022. Parent shall be prepared to define the issues for hearing as previously discussed at the prehearing videoconference held on November 19, 2021. Following completion of the prehearing videoconference, OAH will issue an order stating the issues to be heard at the due process hearing.
