ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR VIDEOCONFERENCE
MEDIATION AND GRANTING REQUEST FOR
CONTINUANCE OF DUE PROCESS HEARING

FEBRUARY 15, 2022

MEDIATION DATE is DENIED. There are no mediators available on March 11, 2022. The parties may submit a new request for a mediation date. Parties advised to select a second choice, especially for a Monday or Friday mediation when available slots may be limited.

PREHEARING CONFERENCE will be held on April 25, 2022, at 3:00 PM. OAH does not schedule Prehearing Conferences the Friday before the start of a hearing as insufficient time to comply with Prehearing Conference orders.

DUE PROCESS HEARING will be held on May 3, 2022 through May 5, 2022. OAH schedules due process hearings for three consecutive days, on Tuesdays through Thursdays. If the parties believe that the hearing will only take two days, they may discuss the hearing schedule with the ALJ at the prehearing conference.

ANY CHANGES TO THE PARTICIPANTS' EMAIL ADDRESSES PROVIDED BY THE PARTIES IN THEIR REQUEST MUST BE FILED TWO BUSINESS DAYS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED EVENT.

The hearing shall begin at 9:30 AM on all days unless otherwise ordered. The hearing shall continue day to day, as needed at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge. Prehearing conference statements and motions are due to OAH no later than three business days before the prehearing conference or with a showing of good cause why it was not timely filed.
