ORDER REGARDING DOCUMENTATION

FEBRUARY 16, 2022

On February 10, 2022, Monrovia Unified School District filed a Motion for Sanctions and Declarations in Support Thereof with the Office of Administrative Hearings, referred to as OAH. Monrovia's motion consisted of 14 pages. The declaration of Elizabeth Orozco did not have a signature reflecting that the statement was made under the penalty of perjury.

On February 15, 2022, Student filed Petitioner's Opposition and Declaration in Response to Respondent's Request for Sanctions. Student's motion consisted of five pages, including a declaration of Anitra Harris. The pleading did not contain legal argument opposing Monrovia's motion.

The pleadings filed by both parties appear to be incomplete. Both parties may refile complete versions of their motions by 10:00 AM on February 18, 2022.
