ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND COMPLAINT

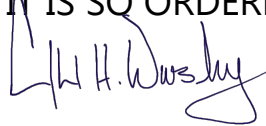
On November 3, 2021, Student filed a Due Process Hearing Request, referred to as a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, also called OAH, naming Justice Street Academy Charter School as respondent. The Office of Administrative Hearings is referred to as OAH. On December 1, 2022, OAH granted Student's motion to amend and file a first amended complaint, adding Los Angeles Unified School District as a respondent. On February 1, 2022, Student filed a motion to amend and file a second amended complaint, adding City of Angels School as a respondent. No opposition was received by OAH.

An amended complaint may be filed when the other party consents in writing and is given the opportunity to resolve the complaint through a resolution session, or when the hearing officer grants permission. The hearing officer may grant permission at any time more than five days before the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(i).) The filing of an amended complaint restarts the applicable timelines for the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).)

The motion to file a second amended complaint was timely filed. Student asserts City of Angels was recently identified as being within the Los Angeles Unified School District. Student therefore seeks to amend the complaint to add City of Angels School as a respondent that is responsible for providing her a free, appropriate public education.

The motion is granted. The second amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this order. All applicable timelines shall be reset as of the date of this order. All previously scheduled dates are hereby vacated. OAH will issue a scheduling order with the new dates.
