ORDER DENYING MOTION TO DISMISS AS MOOT

FEBRUARY 9, 2022

On January 25 2022, Student filed a Request for Due Process Hearing, called a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, referred to as OAH, naming California Connections Academy. OAH granted Student' motion to amend the complaint on February 2, 2022. On February 4, 2022, California Connections Academy filed a motion to dismiss Student's first amended complaint. On February 7, 2022, OAH determined Student's first amended complaint was insufficient in its entirety.

California Connections Academy's motion to dismiss is moot because it pertains to Student's first amended complaint that was determined to be insufficient.

Accordingly, California Connections Academy's motion to dismiss is denied as moot.
