ORDER TAKING NO ACTION ON MOTION TO REINSTATE
DUE PROCESS COMPLAINT

MARCH 09, 2022

On January 21, 2022 Parent on Student's behalf filed a request for due process hearing, called complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearing. Student was represented at the time by counsel. On March 2, 2022, Student's counsel filed a Request to Dismiss the complaint, in Spanish only. OAH issued a Notice of Case Dismissal on the same date.

On March 3, 2022, at 6:24 p.m. Student's counsel filed a Notice of Withdrawal. On March 3, 2022, at 6:47 p.m. Student prior counsel filed a Request to Reopen Case and Provide a Brief Continuance to Find New Counsel.

Student's counsel withdrew from representation before filing the Request to Reopen the case. As such, Student's counsel did not represent Student and therefore could not file any motions or requests on behalf of Student in this matter.

OAH takes no action on the Request to Reopen the Case. The matter remains dismissed without prejudice. Parent may file a Request to Reopen the case if accompanied by a declaration establishing good cause, or Parent may file and serve a new complaint.
