ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE,
CORRECTING NAME OF RESPONDENT

JULY 31, 2023

On July 31, 2023, Administrative Law Judge Christine Arden, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Parent and Student's adult sister appeared on behalf of Student. Melissa Allen, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Taft City School District, erroneously named as Lincoln Junior High School. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

CORRECTED RESPONDENT NAME

The parties stipulated on the record that Respondent's correct name is Taft City School District, not Lincoln Junior High School. The caption in this case is hereby corrected to reflect the corrected name of Respondent.

SETTLEMENT AND VACATION OF ALL DATES

Student and Taft City School District entered into a written settlement agreement of this case on June 26, 2023. That settlement agreement is subject to the approval by the Taft City School District school board, which will be addressed at its school board meeting on August 2, 2023.

There was discussion on the record regarding inconsistencies between the English and Spanish versions of Student's most recent individualized educational program, called an IEP. Mother stated she still wants to enter into the settlement agreement with the district. Therefore, all dates in this case are vacated. The parties were informed that if no one contacts OAH to inform it that the settlement agreement was not approved by the school board by September 1, 2023, OAH will dismiss this case.
