ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO BE RELIEVED AS COUNSEL

JANUARY 24, 2024

On January 24, 2024, Student's attorney filed a motion to be relieved as counsel and for a continuance for Student to obtain a new attorney. A prehearing conference is scheduled in this matter on January 29, 2024, at 1:00 PM.

In due process matters, an attorney may withdraw from representation of a party by filing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, called OAH, a notice of withdrawal. The motion to be relieved as counsel by Student's attorney has the same effect by giving Parents notice that the attorney will no longer represent Student. Accordingly, the motion to be relieved as counsel is granted.

Parent will represent Student without an attorney, until and unless another attorney files a notice of representation of Student in this matter. All future notices and

communication will be directed to Parent at the address for Parent stated in the attorney's motion.

In accordance with OAH guidelines, OAH will wait three business days to rule on the motion for continuance to give Oxnard Union High School District an opportunity to respond. Alternatively, the parties may submit prior to the prehearing conference, a joint request for continuance of the due process hearing to mutually agreed dates supported by a declaration of good cause. If a joint request is not filed with sufficient time for OAH to process and serve an order on the request prior to the prehearing conference, the parties must appear at the prehearing conference held on Zoom on January 29, 2024, at 1:00 PM.
