NOTICE OF NO ACTION ON PETITIONER'S WRITTEN
OBJECTION TO ISSUES AS RESTATED IN ORDER
FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

JANUARY 23, 2024

On October 10, 2023, Parents on behalf of Student filed a request for due process hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings naming Covina-Valley Unified School District, called Covina-Valley, and Azusa Unified School District, called Azusa. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH.

On January 23, 2023, Student filed a written objection to the issues as restated in the Order Following Prehearing Conference dated January 12, 2024.

On January 23, 2023, Student also filed a notice of settlement pending board approval and request to vacate dates, and OAH issued an order vacating dates that same day.

The dates for the due process hearing are currently vacated pending the board meetings for Covina-Valley and Azusa.

Accordingly, no action is taken on Student's written objections to the issues as restated. If the due process hearing in this matter ultimately goes forward, the Administrative Law Judge will address the objections on the first day of hearing.
