ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND COMPLAINT

JANUARY 16, 2024

On December 21, 2023, Parents on behalf of Student filed a due process hearing request, referred to as a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, naming Springs Charter Schools. The Office of Administrative Hearings is referred to as OAH. On January 9, 2024, Student filed a motion to amend the due process hearing request and an amended complaint. The amended complaint changed the name of the respondent from Springs Charter Schools to Pacific Springs Charter School. On January 11, 2024, Springs Charter Schools filed a statement of non-opposition on behalf of Pacific Springs Charter School. The due process hearing is scheduled to begin on February 13, 2024.

An amended complaint may be filed when the other party consents in writing and is given the opportunity to resolve the complaint through a resolution session, or

when the hearing officer grants permission. The hearing officer may grant permission at any time more than five days before the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(i).) The filing of an amended complaint restarts the applicable timelines for the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. § 1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).)

The motion to amend was filed more than five days prior to the due process hearing and Springs Charter Schools, now Pacific Springs Charter School does not oppose amendment. Therefore, it is timely and is granted. The amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this Order. OAH will issue a scheduling order with new hearing dates.
