ORDER OF DISMISSAL

JANUARY 17, 2024

On October 31, 2023, Parent on behalf of Student filed a request for due process hearing, also called a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, naming Los Angeles Unified School District. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH.

On January 17, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Alexa Hohensee convened the due process hearing in this matter by videoconference. Attorneys Sheila Bayne and Connie Zarkowski represented Student. Attorneys Anisha Asher and Rebecca Diddams represented Los Angeles Unified School District. Barbara Rainen appeared on behalf of Los Angeles Unified School District. At the beginning of the hearing, the parties represented that a final agreement had been reached and was being circulated for signatures. The hearing was continued to 11:30 AM for Student to file a request for dismissal.

At 11:02 AM, Student filed with OAH a document entitled Petitioner's Notice of Settlement NOT Pending School Board Approval; Motion to Dismiss Student's Complaint and Due Process Hearing Request with Prejudice; Motion to Vacate All Hearing Dates.

Student's request for dismissal is granted. The matter is dismissed with prejudice. All scheduled dates are vacated.
