ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE FOR
HEARING BY VIDEOCONFERENCE DISMISSING CASE

JANUARY 12, 2024

On January 12, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Rita Defilippis, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Attorney Marymichelle Lotano appeared on behalf of Student. Director of Due Process for San Diego Unified School District, Bryan Spry, appeared on behalf of San Diego Unified School District. The PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

REQUEST TO DISMISS

The parties informed the undersigned ALJ at the beginning of the prehearing conference that they filed signatures of a settlement agreement and a request for dismissal with OAH on January 3, 2024, and again on January 11, 2024. Although counsel for Student received a verification of the filings, no order of dismissal was issued by OAH. The parties shared the settlement agreement on the screen during the virtual prehearing conference and requested that the case be dismissed. The settlement agreement was signed by all parties and is not subject to board approval. The parties' request to dismiss this matter was granted. All dates for hearing are vacated and the case is dismissed.
