ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE FOR
EXPEDITED HEARING BY VIDEOCONFERENCE AND
DISMISSAL OF EXPEDITED ISSUES

FEBRUARY 5, 2024

On February 5, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Sabrina Kong, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Attorney Heather Zakson appeared on Student's behalf. Attorney Angela Gordon appeared on Lancaster Unified School District's, called Lancaster, behalf. The PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order.

Attorney Zakson withdrew all expedited issues and remedies in her due process complaint on the record. Therefore, the expedited hearing is vacated, and the expedited portion of this matter is dismissed.

ORDER INCLUDES ALL RULINGS

This Order includes all rulings made at the PHC. Any discussion and conversation not referenced in this Order is not binding on the ALJ conducting the hearing and may not be relied upon by the parties. The parties should be aware that, at hearing, the ALJ conducting the hearing has discretion to reconsider any part of this Order.
