The Office of Administrative Hearings, called OAH, held a due process hearing in this matter on April 30, and May 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 13, 15, 16, 21, and 22, 2024. Attorney Alexander Rodriguez represented Student. Parent attended all hearing days on Student's behalf. Attorney Jim Sanft represented Classical Academy. Program Specialist Janice Medina attended all hearing days on Classical Academy's behalf. Director of Student Support Services Cori Coffey attended the hearing on April 30, and May 1, 2, 7, 13, 15, 16, 21 and 22, 2024, on Classical Academy's behalf.

At the conclusion of evidence, the parties and the Administrative Law Judge reviewed the exhibits marked as admitted. On June 14, 2024, Classical Academy

informed OAH in writing that Classical Academy's exhibit D159 was not marked as admitted in the electronic evidence program. Classical Academy stated the exhibit was admitted into evidence on May 21, 2024.

OAH has reviewed the audio recording of the hearing held on May 21, 2024, and finds Classical Academy's exhibit D159 was admitted through the testimony of Merrie Candance Salenieks on May 21, 2024. Accordingly, exhibit D159 is marked as admitted in the electronic evidence program.
