ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE FOR
HEARING BY VIDEOCONFERENCE AND VACATING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

JUNE 7, 2024

On May 31, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Cynthia Fritz, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Attorney Meagan Nunez appeared on behalf of Student. Attorney Jim Sanft appeared on behalf of Pacific Springs Charter School. The PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

The parties informed the ALJ that they settled during their mediation earlier that day and Student filed a motion for settlement pending board approval. At the time the prehearing conference commenced, the filing was not yet entered into the OAH electronic filing system. The ALJ trailed the prehearing conference for 15 minutes. When the prehearing conference reconvened, the motion for settlement pending board approval appeared in OAH's electronic filing system. Based upon the information in the motion, the ALJ vacated the prehearing conference. The order vacating the due process hearing pending board approval was sent separately.
