COMPLAINT

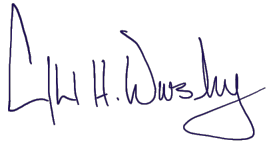
JUNE 19, 2024

On May 15, 2024, Parent on behalf of Student filed a Request for Due Process Hearing with the Office of Administrative Hearings, naming West Contra Costa Unified School District. On May 17, 2024, West Contra Costa Unified School District filed a Notice of Representation by attorney Shawn Olson Brown. On June 14, 2024, Student filed a motion to compel West Contra Costa Unified School District to file a response to Student's complaint, pursuant to 20 United State Code, sections 1415(c)(2)(B)(i)(I). OAH did not receive a response to the motion from West Contra Costa Unified.

OAH has not received a copy of West Contra Costa Unified's response to Student's complaint. West Contra Costa Unified shall serve its response to complaint

upon Student, and file its response with OAH, within three business days from the date of this Order. (*M.C. v. Antelope Valley Union High School Dist.* (9th Cir. 2017) 858 F.3d 1189, 1199-1200.)
