ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND COMPLAINT

JUNE 28, 2024

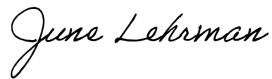
On June 21, 2024, Saddleback Valley Unified School District filed a Due Process Hearing Request, referred to as a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, naming Student. The Office of Administrative Hearings is referred to as OAH. The complaint named both parents and listed a single address for both of them. On June 27, 2024, Saddleback filed a Notice of Errata indicating that parents should have been listed and served at separate addresses, and an amended complaint reflecting that change. The amended complaint is treated as a Motion to Amend the Due Process Hearing Request.

An amended complaint may be filed when the hearing officer grants permission. The hearing officer may grant permission at any time more than five days before the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(i).) The filing of an amended complaint

restarts the applicable timelines for the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. §1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).)

The motion to amend was filed more than five days prior to the due process hearing. Therefore, it is timely and is granted. The amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this order. All applicable timelines shall be reset as of the date of this order. OAH will issue a scheduling order with the new dates.
