ORDER FOLLOWING EXPEDITED PREHEARING
CONFERENCE DISMISSING EXPEDITED ISSUES AND

VACATING DATES

On June 24, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Charles Marson, Office of Administrative Hearings, held an expedited prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Elias R. Economou, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Summer A. Vicknair, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the Capistrano Unified School District. The expedited PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

DISMISSAL OF ALL EXPEDITED ISSUES

At the expedited PHC, Student moved to dismiss all the expedited issues in her complaint. The motion was granted, and all expedited issues were dismissed.

ALL DATES VACATED

The parties then represented that they had reached a final settlement of all remaining issues in this matter and requested that all dates now on calendar be vacated pending approval of Capistrano's School Board, which is expected on August 21, 2024. The request was granted. All dates now on calendar are vacated.
