DISMISSING MATTER WITHOUT PREJUDICE

JUNE 28, 2024

On June 28, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Cole Dalton, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Hali Ford, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Student. Jasey Mahon, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Oxnard Union High School District. The PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

## HEARING DATES, TIMES, AND LOCATION

### MOTION TO DISMISS WITHOUT PREJUDICE

Student moved to dismiss this expedited matter, without prejudice, considering a final settlement agreement requiring board approval. The parties executed the settlement agreement on June 27 and 28, 2024. Student's complaint seeks resolution of only expedited issues.

Given Student's dismissal of this expedited matter, all hearing dates are vacated and the matter is dismissed without prejudice.
