ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND COMPLAINT

OCTOBER 4, 2024

On June 25, 2024, Parents on behalf of Student filed a Due Process Hearing Request, called a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, naming Grossmont Union High School District, called Grossmont. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. On October 2, 2024, Student filed a Motion to Amend the Due Process Hearing Request and an amended complaint. Grossmont filed a non-opposition on October 3, 2024. The due process hearing for this matter is set to begin on October 15, 2024.

An amended complaint may be filed when the other party consents in writing and is given the opportunity to resolve the complaint through a resolution session, or when the hearing officer grants permission. The hearing officer may grant permission at any time more than five days before the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C.

§ 1415(c)(2)(E)(i).) The filing of an amended complaint restarts the applicable timelines for the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. § 1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).)

The motion to amend was filed more than five days prior to the due process hearing and OAH received written consent from Grossmont to the amendment. Therefore, it is timely and is granted. The amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this order. All previously scheduled dates are vacated. All applicable timelines shall be reset as of the date of this order. OAH will issue a scheduling order with the new dates.
