ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE

JULY 21, 2026

On April 29, 2026, Student filed a Request for Due Process Hearing, called a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, called OAH, naming Elk Grove Unified School District, called Elk Grove. Student amended the complaint on May 20, 2026.

On July 21, 2026, OAH held a due process hearing by videoconference. Attorney Leejanice Toback represented Student. Paralegal Eloisa Johnson also attended on behalf of Student. Attorney Rebal Halabi-Boutros represented Elk Grove. OAH provided Communication Access Realtime Translation, called CART, services for Student's attorney. OAH recorded the due process hearing. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

During the due process hearing, Student moved to dismiss the complaint with prejudice based on a settlement agreement recently signed by the parties. Elk Grove did not oppose the request. A petitioner may dismiss a complaint with prejudice any time before the Decision is issued.

Student's request was timely and is granted. All hearing dates for this matter are vacated.
