ONLY

On August 28, 2026, Administrative Law Judge June R. Lehrman, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Student's counsel did not appear. Student's counsel had moved on August 24, and 26, 2026 to continue the expedited prehearing conference, based on her unavailability in order to attend a funeral. OAH denied that request.

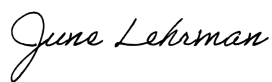
Sundee Johnson, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of Redondo Beach Unified School District. Redondo Beach did not oppose the continuance of the expedited prehearing conference only, so long as the new expedited prehearing conference date was sufficiently in advance of the expedited hearing that is set to occur on September 9 and 10, 2026.

The PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the appearing party, the ALJ issues the following order:
