ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND COMPLAINT

AUGUST 21, 2026

On May 4, 2026, Student filed a Due Process Hearing Request, called a complaint, with the Office of Administrative Hearings, called OAH, naming Santa Ana Unified School District, called Santa Ana. On August 18, 2026, Student filed a Motion to Amend the Due Process Hearing Request and an amended complaint. Santa Ana filed an opposition, contained in its motion to dismiss, on August 20, 2026. The hearing for this matter is set to begin on August 25, 2026.

An amended complaint may be filed when the other party consents in writing and is given the opportunity to resolve the complaint through a resolution session, or when the hearing officer grants permission. The hearing officer may grant permission at any time more than five days before the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C.

§ 1415(c)(2)(E)(i).) The filing of an amended complaint restarts the applicable timelines for the due process hearing. (20 U.S.C. § 1415(c)(2)(E)(ii).)

The motion to amend was filed more than five days prior to the due process hearing. Therefore, it is timely and is granted. The amended complaint shall be deemed filed on the date of this order. All presently set hearing dates are vacated. All applicable timelines shall be reset as of the date of this order. OAH will issue a scheduling order with the new dates.
