ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE FOR
HEARING BY VIDEOCONFERENCE AND DISMISSING THE
CASE

AUGUST 31, 2026

On August 31, 2026, Administrative Law Judge Sabrina Kong, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Attorney Diana Renteria appeared on Student's behalf. Attorney Joshua Walden and law clerk Gillian Lee Coco appeared on Elk Grove Unified School District's, called Elk Grove, behalf. The PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order.

Attorney Renteria represented the case has settled. Attorney Walden represented that the parties have a settlement in principle. The undersigned ALJ informed the parties that the PHC must proceed unless Student was prepared to withdraw the case on the record. Attorney Renteria represented the parties would work out the settlement details, did not wish to proceed with the PHC, and withdrew the case on the record. Therefore, this case is dismissed.
