ORDER FOLLOWING PREHEARING CONFERENCE  
GRANTING STUDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

AUGUST 31, 2026

On August 31, 2026, Administrative Law Judge Ashok Pathi, Office of Administrative Hearings, held a prehearing conference by videoconference. The Administrative Law Judge is called an ALJ. The Office of Administrative Hearings is called OAH. The prehearing conference is called a PHC.

Parent appeared on behalf of Student. Attorney Julia Wolpert appeared on behalf of Perris Union High School District. The PHC was recorded. Based upon discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

## STUDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

Parent did not immediately appear at the beginning of the 10:00 AM PHC. Following phone calls from OAH and Perris counsel, Parent appeared at approximately 10:15 AM.

On the record, Parent informed the undersigned ALJ that the parties had entered into a settlement agreement resolving the current dispute and that she no longer wished to pursue Student's due process matter. The undersigned confirmed Student's request to dismiss, and Parent repeated that she wished to dismiss Student's complaint. Perris did not object.

Accordingly, Student's complaint is dismissed in its entirety. All dates in this matter are vacated.
