

State Employee BikeShare Program

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the State Employee BikeShare Program?

The State Employee BikeShare Program offers DGS employees working in the Sacramento area the ability to travel to nearby meetings and run errands on a bicycle during the workday. The program also promotes worksite wellness, active transportation and environmental stewardship.

Where is the State Employee BikeShare located?

At the State Garage, 1416 10th Street in Sacramento.

Who can use the State Employee BikeShare Program?

All state employees in the Sacramento area who attend the orientation class and sign a waiver can participate in the State Employee BikeShare Program.

Is there a user agreement?

Yes. All employees must sign a liability waiver and release agreement to participate in the program.

Do I have to wear a helmet?

Yes. You must wear a helmet when utilizing the State Employee BikeShare Fleet. You can use a BikeShare helmet or bring your own helmet to use.

Can I keep a bike out all day?

No. The State Employee BikeShare fleet is available for use between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding state holidays.
