

**CALIFORNIA PRESCHOOL, TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN, AND FULL-DAY KINDERGARTEN FACILITIES  
GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING ORDER LOTTERY**

**OCTOBER 19, 2023**

Pursuant to program regulations, a lottery drawing for the remaining funds of the fourth round of the California Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten, and Full-Day Kindergarten Facilities Grant Program will be taking place in person at OPSC’s offices and via Zoom. The event will be webcast, recorded, and archived. Additionally, OPSC has requested an individual that is not an OPSC employee to be present in OPSC’s office to observe the lottery.

The three projects that are in the lottery are from San Lorenzo Unified School District, Los Nietos School District, and Pittsburg Unified School District. The projects are tied at 17 preference points with a Free and Reduced Price Meal percentage of 77.4%. The regulations prescribe that a lottery will take place to determine the order of funding for these projects.

In the first draw, lottery balls 1-10 will represent San Lorenzo USD (SLUSD), lottery balls 11-20 will represent Los Nietos SD (LNSD), and lottery balls 21-30 will represent Pittsburg USD (PUSD). The first number drawn will determine the first project to be offered funding. After the first draw, balls 1-30 will be emptied from the lottery drum. To determine priority projects 2 and 3, lottery balls 31-40 will represent remaining district 2 and balls 41-50 will represent remaining district 3. Whomever is selected in the second draw will receive second priority for funding and the district not chosen in either draw will receive third priority.

The following graphic depicts the drawing order and will be displayed on white board during the webcast. OPSC staff will fill in the names of the districts for the second draw during the webcast.

First Draw	Second Draw
1. SLUSD = 1-10	1. _____ = 31-40
2. LNSD = 11-20	2. _____ = 41-50
3. PUSD = 21-30	

As limited funds are available and will not fully cover each application, if a district is offered a partial grant amount and it is accepted, please note that the grant is considered full and final. If a district declines a partial offer, they may reapply if a future funding round is available.

While project amounts are still being finalized it appears that the SLLUSD project exceeds the remaining funds, while the LNSD and PUSD projects would be able to be fully funded. Therefore, the following scenarios may occur:

Scenario 1.

- SLUSD is drawn first, the district is then offered a partial amount as their project exceeds remaining funds. OPSC will continue with the second draw in the case SLUSD declines a partial offer. If SLUSD accepts the partial offer, LNSD and PUSD will not be funded in this round.

Scenario 2

- If either LNSD or PUSD is drawn first, they will be fully funded. If the second project drawn project is either LNSD or PUSD and they will also be offered full funding, making SLUSD third priority and being offered a partial funding with remaining funds.

### Scenario 3

- If either LNSD or PUSD is drawn first, they will be fully funded. If SLUSD is drawn second they will be offered partial funding, if accepted, the third project will not be funded.
