Dear Ms. Aldaco:

The Office of Public School Construction (OPSC) has completed its review of Tulare Western High, OPSC application number 59/72249-00-001. Review of the District's project financing, expenditures, and certifications to ensure compliance pursuant to Education Code Sections 17072.35, 17074.25, and 17076.10 and School Facility Program (SFP) Regulation Section 1859.106 was conducted. In addition, the review examined the District's compliance with applicable SFP Regulations in effect when the funding application was received by OPSC, dated April 30, 2008.

The project is a non-financial hardship Career Technical Education Facilities Program (CTEFP) project that was funded on a 50 percent State and 50 percent District basis. SFP Regulation Section 1859.199 states "an applicant district may not retain savings realized by a Career Technical Education Facilities Project." Accordingly, the State share of any savings not needed for the project is returned to the State.

OPSC has identified \$45,143.07 in review adjustments for ineligible furniture and equipment expenditures. The project savings amount has been adjusted to reflect this finding.

This CTEFP project has savings in the amount of \$45,122.32. Pending final approval by the State Allocation Board at its next available monthly meeting, the District will be invoiced \$22,561.16 for the reduction in the apportionment.

OPSC has received the signed *Summary of Project Financing and Expenditures* dated February 8, 2019 from the District. As the District has concurred with the review findings in the *Summary of Project Financing and Expenditures*, the project is considered closed. Enclosed is the final report.

SCHOOL FACILITY PROGRAM CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION FACILITIES PROGRAM RESCISSION

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To present a rescission under the School Facility Program (SFP) Career Technical Education Facilities Program (CTEFP).

DESCRIPTION

The CTEFP project listed on the Attachment received an apportionment at the December 2008 State Allocation Board meeting. The District has requested to rescind a portion of the adjusted grant due to a change of scope approved by the California Department of Education (CDE).

AUTHORITY

Assembly Bill 127 (Chapter 35, Statutes of 2006-Nunez and Perata) established the CTEFP within the SFP. Education Code Section 17078.72 provides \$500 million from Proposition 1D for qualifying applicants to construct or modernize facilities and to purchase equipment for career technical education programs at high schools.

SFP Regulation Section 1859.198 states that "any Career Technical Education Facilities Project funds returned due to projects being rescinded or reduced to costs incurred shall be made available for apportionment in subsequent funding cycles."

SFP Regulation Section 1859,194 allows qualifying applicants to request a loan if the matching share is unavailable.

STAFF COMMENTS

The District shown on the Attachment is requesting to rescind its project and a portion of its adjusted grant due to a change of scope approved by the CDE.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the request for a partial rescission for the project as shown on the Attachment.

Staff is requesting an adjustment to the previous approval of the project, made at the December 8, 2008 SAB, due to a change of scope which was approved by the Celifornia Department of Education.

A portion of the adjusted grant of \$41,500 is being returned to the CTEFP fund. No State funds have been released.

Pursuant to the District's certifications on the Form SAB 50-10 and to Section 1859.199, the retention of the apportionment is subject to OPSC verification of the eligible project costs, as identified in Section 1859.193, contained in the California Department of Education Plan Approval and final Division of the State Architect approved plans and specifications.

Pursuant to Section 1859.197, the District is required to submit a complete Fund Release Authorization (Form SAB 50-05) within 18 months of the OPSC acceptance of the California Department of Education plan approval and the Division of the State Architect approved plans and specifications; otherwise, the apportionment will be rescinded without further Board action.

Pursuant to Section 1859.199, provide that the State portion of any and all project savings realized from the funding of a Career Technical Education Fedities Program project must be returned to the State.

The District shall ensure that it is in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations and certifications it made on the program forms.

The next step is to submit an Application for CTE Facilities Funding (Form SAB 50-10) to the Office of Public School Construction (OPSC) for funding consideration no later than Wednesday, April 30, 2008. Funding order will be based on all the numerical scores in your County Superintendents Service Region and locale where the school resides. The scope and budget of the project submitted to OPSC must be consistent with the application approved by the California Department of Education (CDE).
