# REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER State Allocation Board Meeting, January 26, 2011

#### ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT TO SCHOOL FACILITY PROGRAM GRANTS

### PURPOSE OF REPORT

To adopt the annual adjustment in the School Facility Program (SFP) Grants based on the change in construction costs pursuant to the Education Code (EC) and SFP Regulations.

### **DESCRIPTION**

This item provides a comparison of several construction cost indices and shows the rate of change for the current year. The Board must select an index to be used to adjust the SFP grants amounts for calendar year 2011.

### <u>AUTHORITY</u>

For New Construction grant, EC Section 17072.10(b) states, "The Board shall annually adjust the perunhoused-pupil apportionment to reflect construction cost changes, as set forth in the statewide cost index for class B construction as determined by the Board." EC Section 17072.11(a)(3) states, "The Board shall conduct an analysis of the relationship between the per-unhoused-pupil grant eligibility determined under this article and the per-pupil cost of new school construction for elementary, middle, and high school pupils."

For Modernization funding, EC Section 17074.10(b) states, "The Board shall annually adjust the factors set forth in subdivision (a) according to the adjustment for inflation set forth in the statewide cost index for class B construction, as determined by the board."

SFP Regulations Section 1859.71 states, "The new construction per-unhoused-pupil grant amount, as provided by Education Code Section 17072.10(a), will be adjusted annually based on the change in the Class B Construction Cost Index as approved by the Board each January. The new construction per-unhoused-pupil grant amount, as provided by Education Code Section 17072.10(a), may be increased by an additional amount not to exceed six percent in a fiscal year, or decreased, based on the analysis of the current cost to build schools as reported on the Project Information Worksheet (New 09/07) which shall be submitted with the Forms SAB 50-05 and 50-06 and as approved by the Board."

For the assistance on Small School Districts' new construction projects, SFP Regulations Section 1859.73.1 and Section 1859.78.2 both states the amount will be adjusted annually based on the change in the Class B Construction Cost Index as approved by the Board each January.

SFP Regulations Section 1859.78 states, "The modernization per-unhoused-pupil grant amount, as provided by Education Code Section 17074.10(a), will be adjusted annually based on the change in the Class B Construction Cost Index as approved by the Board each January."

### BACKGROUND

Statute requires an annual adjustment to the per-unhoused-pupil grant amounts of the SFP based on the change in the Class B Construction Cost Index (CCI) each January.

Prior to January 1, 2005, base grant amount adjustments were based on the Marshall & Swift (M&S) Ten Western States Index. At the March 2005 State Allocation Board (SAB) meeting, the Board adopted the M&S Eight California Cities Index as the index most closely reflecting the building climate in California. In December 2007, the Board used the M&S Ten Western States Index. The 2009 and 2010 adjustment was made according to the M&S Eight California Cities Index.

## STAFF ANALYSIS

Staff recommends the M&S Eight California Cities Index since it most accurately reflects the conditions under which districts will be building their schools with the SFP. The M&S Eight California Cities Index is the only Class B index that uses exclusively California cities to capture material and prevailing wage costs in California.

The M&S Eight California Cities CCI increased by 4.28 percent during the period of January 1, 2010 through January 1, 2011. The figures shown on Attachment A reflect the calculated increase. Attachment A also notes the specific regulation sections.

Attachment B also shows the CCI for Lee Saylor and M&S Ten Western States.

### RECOMMENDATION

Adopt the M&S Eight California Cities CCI adjustment for 2011 SFP grants.

This Item was approved by the State Allocation Board on January 26, 2011.
