

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF HARDSHIP FUNDS

District staff is hereby authorized and directed, jointly and severally, to do any and all things which they may deem necessary or advisable in order to consummate the transactions herein authorized and otherwise to carry out, give effect to and comply with the terms and intent of this Resolution, including, without limitation, executing agreements, certifications and other necessary documents and transmitting documents to OPSC to indicate compliance with OPSC regulations.

Section 5. All actions heretofore taken by the officers, employees and agents of the District with respect to the transactions set forth above are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption.
