The program replaces existing third-party and equipment manufacturer service contracts and enables departments to reduce the annual cost of equipment maintenance, improve service performance, and enhance tracking of maintenance events and costs.

- Information Technology systems
- Telephone and voicemail systems
- BioMedical, Imaging, Laboratory
- PC's, laptops, printers, scanners, plotters
- Mailing systems Audio/visual systems
- Office automation equipment (copiers/multi-function/fax machines)
- Other equipment may be eligible.
