### Preamble

This Formulary will be known as the State of California Common Drug Formulary (CDF). In consultation with state, county and local governmental entities, the formulary is managed and maintained by the California Department of General Services (DGS) Pharmaceutical Acquisitions Section. With consent from DGS Pharmaceutical Acquisitions Section and in compliance with DGS pricing agreements and contracts, the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR); California Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ); California Department of State Hospitals (DSH); California Department of Developmental Services (DDS); and other California state, county and local government agencies have agreed to incorporate, in whole or in part, the DGS Common Drug Formulary in their departmental formularies to have access to DGS contracted pricing agreements.

It is the goal of DGS' Pharmaceutical Acquisitions Section to collaborate and consult with participating departments to identify pharmaceutical products that are the most appropriate and cost-effective to treat their patient population.

## Policy Statement

### Purpose

The Common Drug Formulary (CDF) provides state, county, and local government entities a list of contracted medications that are safe, efficacious, and cost effective.

### Policy

1. Pursuant to Title 2: Government of the State of California, Division 3: Executive Department, Part 5.5: Department of General Services, Chapter 12: Purchase of Prescription Drugs for Government Agencies, Sections: 14977 – 14982 and in consultation with mandated and non-mandated participating California state, county or municipal governmental entities, DGS may enter into contracts with manufacturers, wholesalers, pharmaceutical benefit managers or other entities to address the rising cost of prescription medications.
2. Mandated participating DGS entities must inform and collaborate with DGS on current and/or potential utilization of a drug or program. Additionally, mandated participating DGS entities must not, unilaterally, take action up to but not limited to initiating a contract negotiation with another party that may impact current and future DGS pricing agreements in achieving the greatest savings for state, county and local governmental agencies.
3. Pursuant to DGS contracted formulary drug pricing agreements, contracted formulary required drugs must be included on the participating entity's formulary to take advantage of the DGS negotiated price.
4. When DGS awards a contract with a formulary "Exclusive" status to a biological or non-biological molecule, additional drugs from the same therapeutic/sub-category may not be part of a participating department's formulary.
5. DGS may award a contract to a pharmaceutical manufacturer for a drug with a "Non-Formulary" status.
6. With consent from DGS, participating California governmental entities may restrict the use of DGS contracted formulary drugs for reasons that may include but not limited to safety and/or relevant operational needs such as inventory shortage.
7. Prescription drug proposal for CDF consideration that may or may not lead to a DGS contract or pricing agreement must include, but not limited, to:
  - a. Utilization data (current and projected).
  - b. Treatment protocol or similar inclusion/exclusion status (current and projected).
  - c. Formulary status (current and projected).
  - d. Safety and operations issues.

- e. Therapeutic drug class and disease state review that may include best practice guidelines, outcome studies and other peer-reviewed literature.
- f. The Joint Commission (TJC) criteria for drug use that includes but not limited to indications, effectiveness, drug interactions, potential for errors and abuse and adverse drug reaction.
