# State of California Purchasing Standard Carpet

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this purchasing standard is to set the postconsumer by weight requirement for carpeting in order to label a purchase as Environmentally Preferable Purchasing (EPP).

# **Authority**

Pursuant to <u>Public Resources Code Section 42982</u>, it requires DGS to determine the minimum amount of postconsumer content for carpeting purchased by state agencies as outlined in the State Contracting Manual (SCM).

# **Background**

<u>PCC §12400-12404</u> defines environmentally preferable purchasing as the procurement or acquisition of goods and services that have a lesser or reduced effect on human health and the environment when compared with competing goods or services that serve the same purpose.

<u>Executive Order N-19-19</u> directs departments to purchase and use environmentally preferable products and services to minimize greenhouse gas emissions and mitigate the impacts of climate change.

<u>PCC §12200-12217</u> establishes the State Agency Buy Recycled Campaign (SABRC) and declares that it is the policy of the state to conserve and protect its resources.

## Requirements

Suppliers who offer carpet products must submit, at time of bid, documentation demonstrating that the product offered meets both:

- Compliant to standard NSF/ANSI 140 platinum tier
- Contains a minimum of 15% post-consumer recycled content by weight for the entirety of the carpeting product (excluding padding and packaging).

When removing postconsumer carpet from state buildings, it shall be managed in a manner consistent with PRC 42970-42983.
