## 1.0 SCOPE

DGS Purchasing Standards provide the minimum criteria purchases must meet to be considered Environmentally Preferable (EPP), aka "green", by the state of California, to be used for incorporating requirements that meet the state's environmentally preferable goals, into procurements and policy.

Per Public Contract Code (PCC) §12400 through 12404, Environmentally Preferable Purchasing, the purchasing standard herein establishes minimum EPP requirements for Laundry Services henceforth, services.

Laundry Services consist of washing, drying, pressing and/or dry cleaning of stateowned clothing, linens, and other items. Contracts can also include the transport of these items to and from the facilities, which can be subject to SmartWay certification.

A "green" laundry service could require the use of Bio Preferred products and the employment of sustainable practices to conserve water and energy. The third-party certification Energy Star, registers and labels washing and drying machines that conserve these resources.

## 2.0 APPLICABLE LAWS and INDUSTRY STANDARDS

Departments must adhere to all applicable laws, regulations, policies, best practices, and purchasing authority requirements, e.g. California Codes, California Code of Regulations, State Administrative Manual, Management Memos, and State Contracting Manual Volume 2 and 3, as applicable. ## 3.0 ENVIRONMENTALLY PREFERABLE PURCHASING REQUIREMENTS

Products must be certified by a minimum of one third-party environmental certification per Table 1, and/or contain a minimum of 30% postconsumer recycled content (PCRC) to be considered EPP. Laundry Products must contain a minimum of 30% PCRC to be considered State Agency Buy Recycled Campaign (SABRC) compliant.

- Choose Dry Cleaning practices that utilize non-toxic solvents, specifically excluding Perchloroethylene, and belonging to the USDA's Bio Preferred Program
- > Choose Laundry Products with a minimum 35% Biobased Content
- Choose Polybags that can filter out 65% of microplastics and other material fibers
- Choose Transport services to and from facilities from an EPA SmartWay partner
  - Alternatively refer to Transportation Services purchasing standard for other shipping options.
