State of California Purchasing Standard Seating

1.0 SCOPE

DGS Purchasing Standards provide the minimum criteria purchases must meet to be considered Environmentally Preferable (EPP), aka "green", by the state of California. They establish a mechanism for incorporating performance and environmental requirements that meet the state's environmentally preferable goals, into procurements and policy.

Per Public Contract Code (PCC) §12400 through 12404, Environmentally Preferable Purchasing, the purchasing standard herein establishes minimum EPP requirements for seating, henceforth, products. These EPP requirements reduce potential impact to the environment and public health by reducing toxics in seating.

2.0 APPLICABLE LAWS and INDUSTRY STANDARDS

Departments must adhere to all applicable laws, regulations, policies, best practices, and purchasing authority requirements, e.g. California Codes, California Code of Regulations (CCR), State Administrative Manual, Management Memos, and State Contracting Manual Volume F, 2, and 3, as applicable.

3.0 ENVIRONMENTALLY PREFERABLE PURCHASING REQUIREMENTS

Products must be certified by a minimum of one corresponding Third- Party Environmental Certification program: <u>Greenguard Gold</u>, <u>SCS Indoor Advantage™ Gold</u> or <u>BIFMA level®</u> (must be certified with Credit 7.6.1, 7.6.2, & 7.6.3) to be considered EPP.

Certified seating meets low emissions standard and is eligible for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) credits. EO B-18-12 requires certain new or renovated state buildings and build-to-suit leases to be LEED Silver certified.

Bidders or vendors shall provide the <u>BIFMA Scorecard</u> for each certified product to show the achievement of Credit 7.6.1, 7.6.2, and 7.6.3.

4.0 OPTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Products may meet the following optional requirements in this section to potentially further reduce environmental and human health impact.

- Upholstered seating free of per-fluorinated and poly-fluorinated alkyl compounds (PFCs), and fluorinated polymers used as stain, water, or oil resistant treatments.
- Upholstered seating free of added or built-in chemical antimicrobials.
