I: Executive Summary

The Statewide Consolidated Annual Report (CAR) provides information on the contract dollars awarded by state departments toward the 25 percent Small Business/Micro Business (SB/MB) goal and 3 percent Disabled Veterans' Business Enterprise (DVBE) goal in state procurement and contracting. As required by Public Contract Code 10111, state departments must annually report to the Department of General Services (DGS) the total awarded state dollars on Information Technology (IT) and non-IT goods and services, construction, and Cal-Card transactions.

For fiscal year (FY) 2017-18, DGS received 158 total reports from state agencies and departments, including 132 of the 133 mandatory reporting departments, and 26 of the 31 voluntary reporting departments that were not required, but elected to report participation.¹ Based on the data provided by mandatory reporting departments, the state met both SB/MB and DVBE participation goals, reporting 32.5 percent and 4.7 percent, respectively. This represents a 6 percent increase by mandatory departments from the previous fiscal year's reported participation of 26.6 percent SB/MB participation, and a 0.6 percent increase from the previous fiscal year's reported 4.1 percent DVBE participation. This is the fifth year in a row that the state has met the SB/MB participation goal, and the tenth year in a row that the state has met the DVBE participation goal with mandatory departments' data.

Collectively, mandatory and voluntary departments awarded more than \$10.5 billion in total contracts. Of that total, departments awarded \$3.1 billion to certified SB/MB firms and \$461 million to DVBE firms, achieving 29.2 percent participation for SBs/MBs and 4.4 percent participation for DVBEs.

To assist departments with meeting SB/MB and DVBE goals in future years, the Outreach section of DGS' Office of Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise Services (OSDS Branch) is committed to expanding statewide outreach for DVBEs and SBs/MBs through education and business opportunity enhancements. In 2017-18, the Outreach section engaged in efforts and strategies designed to assist departments in achieving their contract participation goals, including state agency visits. In this report, Section II, "What Does DGS Do to Help with SB/DVBE Participation?" describes the details of these outreach efforts.

Listed below are the most significant changes from last year's CAR, according to the data reported. A more detailed discussion of the data will follow in Sections III-VIII.

¹Mandatory departments are under DGS' delegated authority and are required to report SB and DVBE participation each fiscal year. Voluntary departments are statutorily exempt from reporting this data, but may choose to do so.

- Mandatory departments' awards increased for SBs/MBs by \$1 billion (or 62.0 percent) and for DVBEs by \$128 million (or 49.4 percent), when compared to last year's awards of \$1.7 billion and \$259 million, respectively.
- Non-IT Goods had the highest participation rate for both SB/MB and DVBE contracts, at 56.3 percent and 7.6 percent, respectively.
- Service industry certifications were dominant among both SB/MB and DVBE firms, compared to other industry types.
- Consulting Services Contract awards (new and amendments) doubled from the previous fiscal year, reaching \$1.53 billion.
- SB/DVBE Option awards increased from \$431 million in fiscal year 2016-17 to \$527 million in 2017-18.
- DVBE Incentive awards increased from \$194 million in fiscal year 2016-17 to \$331 million in 2017-18.
- I-Bond awards decreased from \$31 million in the previous fiscal year to \$5 million.

II. What Does DGS Do to Help with SB/DVBE Participation?

DGS' OSDS Branch has worked diligently to increase the state's pool of qualified SB and DVBE certified suppliers through customer outreach efforts to assist departments in achieving their contract participation goals.

In summary, OSDS made the following outreach efforts last year:

- Reviewed and contacted mandatory reporting departments that failed to meet their SB and/or DVBE goals. Outreach provided these departments with a contracting best practices checklist and referred them to the Outreach resources page, which provides helpful resources and tools.
- Developed an SB/DVBE Resources and Best Practices page for buyers and advocates to support the inclusion of SBs and DVBEs in procurement:

- Established and maintained strategic partnerships with 35 diverse organizations that support and help DGS to fulfill the SB/DVBE program mission.
- Implemented a strategic partners survey to evaluate outreach efforts in fulfilling the SB/DVBE program's mission in providing education, training and advocacy on the state's procurement process for the SB and DVBE communities.
- Supported three major design-build projects to reach an SB participation goal of 25 percent and a DVBE goal of 3 percent. OSDS Branch worked with DGS' Office of Business Acquisitions Services (OBAS) to ensure contracts have clear SB/DVBE language and partnered with the selected design-build prime contractors to increase SB/DVBE awareness and participation on each project.
- Increased awareness of DGS' SB/DVBE programs and resources available to suppliers through the use of radio interviews, print advertisement, webinars and focused outreach.
- DGS' Business Development Program hosted the annual winter business showcase to identify prospective SB/DVBE bidders to contact when using the SB/DVBE Option or SB/DVBE First Policy. The showcase included one-on-one business matchmaking sessions, "meet the prime" opportunities, and state agencies' exhibit tables.
- Designed a workshop survey used to gather information from the SB/DVBE business community. The data results are used to modify and improve the workshops to better serve the SB and DVBE communities.

- Updated reciprocity program letters and flyers to expand the Reciprocity Program to new cities, counties, municipal districts and private corporations.
- Hosted an annual business summit to increase certified DVBEs, in collaboration with the California Department of Veterans Affairs (CalVet). CalVet sent out a welcome packet with additional tools and resources to newly certified DVBEs.
- The advocate steering committee facilitated four quarterly workshops to share SB/DVBE contracting best practices and serve as a training and informational forum for advocates.
- Held the 18th annual State Agency Recognition Awards (SARA). Every January, SARA honors state departments and employees for their best practices, creativity, and outstanding achievements to advance California’s SB and DVBE programs.

OSDS Branch will continue to support departments’ SB/DVBE participation success in the following ways:

- Each year, departments that do not meet mandated minimum participation goals are required to complete an Improvement Plan. The Improvement Plan gives departments an opportunity to provide an explanation about why their department did not meet the minimum SB and/or DVBE contracting participation goal, lay out strategies to improve their performance, and describe in detail the challenges and barriers they face with meeting the SB and/or DVBE goals. The OSDS Branch reviews these plans to help DGS better address the department’s specific needs and provide additional strategies and best practices to correct their course for the future. The OSDS Branch schedules meetings with departments to share best practices and follows up as needed to monitor progress.
- The OSDS Branch maintains and provides marketing material to assist departments with limited resources so they can participate in outreach events. III: SB/MB Participation

A: SB/MB Department Participation Data

Mandatory departments exceeded the 25 percent SB/MB minimum participation goal for fiscal year 2017-18, achieving SB/MB contract participation of 32.6 percent, an increase of 6 percentage points from 26.6 percent in fiscal year 2016-17 (Table 1).

Mandatory departments accounted for 86.2 percent of all 128,600 SB/MB contracts awarded statewide, and 88.7 percent of the \$10.55 billion total contract dollars spent in 2017-18 by all the reporting departments statewide. SB/MB firms received over \$3 billion of the total dollars awarded, \$2.7 billion of which was from mandatory departments.

Mandatory departments increased total contract awards by \$2 billion and SB/MB awards by \$1 billion from 2016-17. Compared to 2016-17, the average SB/MB award amount increased 72.2 percent, from \$14,286 to \$24,596 per contract.

B: SB/MB Contracting Dollars by Activity

Table 2 below identifies SB/MB percentages and total dollars awarded in 2017-18 by mandatory departments, by contract activity.

Goods (Non-IT) had the highest SB/MB participation at 56.3 percent. This category also increased the most from the previous fiscal year, rising 16 percentage points.

Construction and Services (Non-IT) exceeded the SB/MB 25 percent participation goal, reaching 32.1 percent and 30.2 percent, respectively. Each of the two categories also increased approximately 10 percentage points from the previous fiscal year.

Cal Card Data and IT Goods and Services contracting activity reached 24.3 percent and 21.4 percent, respectively. Although total IT spending increased compared to last fiscal year, IT participation by SBs/MBs dropped by 8.8 percentage points because SB/MB awards did not

increase proportionally. Total IT spending increased by \$700 million, but SB/MB IT awards only increased by \$60 million.

C: SB/MB Firms by Type

At the end of 2017-18, there were 18,366 certified SB firms in the certification database (Table 3). In 2017-18, the number of certified SB firms declined by 3,155 firms (14.7 percent) from 2016-17. This decline continues to be primarily attributed to the end of extensions the OSDS granted during the Financial Information System for California pre- and post-implementation activities, such that firms whose certification had been extended since 2014 had their certifications expire or failed to recertify. Firms with fewer than 25 employees make up the majority of SBs certified, accounting for 88.2 percent of all certified SB firms in 2017-18.


At the end of the 2017-18 fiscal year, there were 18,366 SB firms of which 13,040 (71 percent) were MB firms. (Table 4)

Figure 1 below shows SB/MB firms by industry type. Some of the certified SBs/MBs are active in more than one industry, so the firm count by business industry is not equal to the total number of firms in each industry.

Figure 1: SB/MB Firms by Industry Type



Service proved to be the most prevalent industry type, with 12,830 firms (71.6 percent). Since firms may certify under more than one industry, many of the firms certified as service are likely also certified as non-manufacturing or construction.

IV: DVBE Participation

A: DVBE Department Participation Data

Mandatory departments exceeded the 3 percent DVBE minimum contracting requirement for 2017-18, achieving DVBE participation of 4.7 percent in 2017-18, representing a slight increase from 4.1 percent in 2016-17 (Table 5).

Mandatory departments accounted for 90 percent of the 21,310 total DVBE contracts awarded and 79.2 percent of the \$10.5 billion total contract dollars awarded statewide in 2017-18. DVBE firms received \$461 million of the total dollars spent, \$387 million of which was from mandatory departments.

Mandatory departments increased total contract spending by \$2 billion and DVBE spending by \$128 million from 2016-17. Likewise, the number of DVBE contracts awarded by mandatory departments increased by about 500 from 2016-17. Compared to 2016-17, the average DVBE award amount increased 45.4 percent, from \$13,877 to \$20,184 per contract.

B: DVBE Contracting Dollars by Activity

Table 6 below compares DVBE and total awards in 2017-18 by mandatory departments, separated by contract activity.

Non-IT Goods, Construction, and IT (Goods & Services) exceeded the DVBE 3 percent participation goal. Non-IT Services and Cal Card Data only reached 2.2 percent and 2.1 percent, respectively. There were no significant changes from the previous fiscal year; all categories remained within 1 percentage point of last fiscal year's data.

³SB/MB and DVBE total contract dollars are not equal because the California Correctional Health Care System (under California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation) is exempt from reporting non-IT services for inmate medical services for DVBE participation, per Public Contract Code 10115.11(b).

C: DVBE Firms by Type


At the end of the 2017-18 fiscal year, there were 1,688 certified DVBE firms (Table 6), comparable to 1,784 DVBE firms in the database at the end of the previous fiscal year. More than half of the DVBE firms (864 firms, or 51.2 percent) were certified as DVBE only, meaning that they did not also certify as an SB or MB.

Figure 2 below shows DVBE firms by industry type. Some of the certified DVBEs are active in more than one industry, so the firm count by business industry is not equal to the total number of firms in each industry.

As with SB/MB firms, the Service industry type was the most common for DVBEs, with 1,380 firms (81.8 percent).

V: Consulting Services Contracting Activity

The State Contract Act in Public Contract Code Section 10111 requires state entities to report all consulting services contracts that are awarded, amended and completed during a fiscal year. Consulting services contracts are services of an advisory nature, in which the final product is the transmittal of information in either written or verbal form.

Table 7 below shows the reported activity for 2017-18. The significant changes from the previous fiscal year are as follows:


- Contracts awarded and amended during 2017-18 were worth approximately \$1.53 billion, an increase of \$769 million (101 percent) from \$761 million in 2016-17.
- The number of awarded contracts increased by 242 (20.4 percent).
- The number of completed contracts increased by 268 (31.9 percent).
- The dollar amounts for awarded and completed contracts nearly doubled.

Mandatory departments represented 69.6 percent of awards or amendments for the total of 3,253 consulting service contracts for the fiscal year (Figure 3). Of all departments submitting a consulting services contract report, 19 percent did not report consulting services activities for 2017-18, similar to 20 percent in 2016-17.

VI: Small Business (SB) and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE) Options and the DVBE Incentive

The SB and DVBE Option procurement method is statutorily permitted by Government Code Sections 14838.5(a) and 14838.7(a). Departments may use the SB or DVBE Option by contracting directly with SB or DVBE firms after obtaining price quotes from at least two such firms. This option applies for goods and services contracts greater than \$5,000 and less than \$250,000, and up to \$314,000 for public works contracts, and does not require following the state’s usual formal competitive bidding requirements.

State law also requires awarding departments to apply a “DVBE Incentive” on all competitive procurements to provide an advantage for DVBE firms. For evaluation purposes only, the state shall apply an incentive to bids that propose California certified DVBE participation as identified on the Bidder Declaration. The incentive amount for awards based on low price will vary in conjunction with the percentage of DVBE participation.

Table 8 below shows the reported usage of the SB/DVBE Option and DVBE Incentive for 2017-18. The significant changes from the previous fiscal year are as follows:

- SB and DVBE Option total awards increased by \$96 million (22.3 percent), reaching \$527 million.
- Of the 128 statewide departments that reported, 93 utilized the SB and DVBE Option, down from the previous fiscal year by 23 departments (19.8 percent).
- DVBE Incentive total award dollars jumped 70.6 percentage points, from \$194 million to \$331 million.
- Of the 128 statewide departments that reported, 33 utilized the DVBE Incentive, comparable to 34 departments in the previous fiscal year.

VII: SB and DVBE Infrastructure Bond Acts of 2006 (I-Bond)

Government Code Section 14838.1(f) requires entities to report all contracting activity using the Infrastructure Bond (I-Bond) and mandates a 25 percent participation of Small Business in the construction of the state’s infrastructure, as provided in specified I-Bond Acts of 2006. State departments report the usage of I-Bond funds for the following bond acts:

- Air Quality, Highway Safety Traffic Reduction, and Port Security.
- Disaster Preparedness and Flood Prevention.
- Emergency Shelter Trust Fund and Housing.
- Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection, Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply.
- Kindergarten-University Public Education Facilities.

State departments that do not meet this goal must submit a plan of action to increase SB participation in future fiscal years. Three of the five departments that utilized I-Bond funds achieved mandatory minimum SB participation achievement of 25 percent.

Table 9 below shows the reported usage of I-Bond funds. Overall, the state met the minimum SB participation goal of 25 percent on contracts using I-Bond funds, reaching 36.8 percent of the total contract dollars at \$5.26 million. This is 27.6 percentage points higher than last fiscal year’s SB participation rate of 9.2 percent. The I-Bond DVBE achievement for 2017-18 was 1.62 percent, slightly higher than the prior year’s DVBE achievement of 0.02 percent.⁴

The number of departments using I-Bond funding has steadily decreased over the past several fiscal years. The last time more than 10 departments used the I-Bond funds was in in 2013-14. Only five departments reported use of the I-Bond funds for 2017-18.

VIII: Ethnicity, Race, Gender and Sexual Orientation (ERGSO)

Public Contract Code Section 10111(f) encourages businesses contracting with the state to voluntarily provide information on the business owner's ethnicity, race, gender, and sexual orientation. Departments are required to report on the ethnicity, race, gender and sexual orientation of business owners who voluntarily provide such information. Awarding departments are required to send a Voluntary Statistical Data Sheet (VSDS) to every business owner who is awarded a contract. The Ethnicity, Race, Gender and Sexual Orientation (ERGSO) report is an accumulation of all VSDS forms that are returned to state departments by businesses participating in contracts.

ERGSO data is captured for goods, services, and construction. The same contract may be reported in more than one classification. As an example, a business owner may indicate gender and ethnicity classifications for a contract. When multiple boxes are selected by the business submitting the VSDS, it is unclear if the preparer is reporting these categories for the owner(s), employees, the customers they serve, or a combination thereof.

Departments continue to report that many VSDS forms are not returned by business owners. Due to the complexity of defining race and ethnicity (as some people identify with more than one race or ethnicity), and the fact that only 41.4 percent of reporting departments had ERGSO data to report in 2017-18, the ERGSO data provided in this report has been determined not to be characteristic of business owners contracting with the state; therefore, extreme caution is advised when interpreting or analyzing these results.

Below are the most significant changes from the previous fiscal year, as reported:

- **Ethnicity**
 - Total contracts to Hispanic ethnicities increased by \$32 million.
 - Construction contracts to other ethnicities decreased by \$45 million.⁵
- **Race**
 - Contracts to white races increased by \$61 million in goods and \$58 million in construction.
 - Construction contracts to other races decreased by \$60 million.
- **Gender**
 - Contracts to females increased by \$40 million in goods and \$29 million in construction.
 - Services contracts to males decreased by \$49 million.
- **Sexual Orientation**
 - Services contracts to gay business owners increased by \$1.2 million.
 - Construction contracts to bisexual business owners decreased by \$810,000.

⁵"Other" ethnicity is any group of natural persons identified as minorities in the respective project specifications of an awarding department.

IX: Glossary of Terms

A: Definitions

Consulting Services	Services of an advisory nature where the final product is a transmittal of information either written or verbal.
Mandatory reporting departments	Departments that are under Department of General Services' statutory purchasing authority.
