 - ✓ Recycle some services cannot be obtained from an SB
 - ✓ Statewide contract off-ramp using off-ramp where contract does not prohibit returns. Primes are designating SB/DVBE orders for goods nonreturnable.
 - ✓ Statewide agreements open to more SB/DVBE
 - ✓ CMAS change to language in support of SB/DVBEs; increase number
 of SB/DVBE vendors that are required to be sent offers.
 - ✓ Exempt reporting for Statewide contracts Vehicles

- What Works to Achieve Goals: SB 47.2% and DVBE 8.33%
 - DVBE First Policy
 - ✓ Non-It under 100.00 award to DVBE /SB
 - ✓ SB/DVBE Option
 - ✓ Solicit DVBE's first, then SB's, then open solicitation to all
 - DVBE Goal Setting Policy
 - ✓ Mandated goals \$10,000 \$200,000 = 3% Goal
 - ✓ Over 200k = 5% Goal
 - ✓ Higher or lower goal may be set based on opportunities for subcontracting or supplies
 - ✓ Letter to subcontractors with executed contract to primes
 - Technical assistance
 - Waiver
 - ✓ Track number and types of contracts

 - SB-PW Certification Type will be available for selection on Cal eProcure

Fi\$cal Update: Reports Availability – Susan Sudman

- New CAR Functionality available March 2019
 - CAR reports multi funding pulls only the dollars requested
 - Contract exempt from Incentive/Services requirement
 - ERGSO Report
 - ✓ Data entry page
- Broadcast trainings forthcoming in February
- Plan for CAR reporting:
 - June a Broadcast form DGS advising departments to run report query for comparisons, analysis, and clean-up.
 - August 1st, Fi\$cal Lockdown
 - August 2nd, DGS runs all department reports
 - Extension Request must be submitted prior to August 1st and report will be ran at a later date.
- Responses to questions:
 - System captures P-card
 - LPAs will be captured

- January 8th, email sent to all advocates requesting submission of agency's "Look-Ahead Report" of upcoming procurements and post to department's website.
 - If you have not submitted reports please contact DGS to let them know the reason.
 - Request is direct from the DGS SB advisory council, which is chaired by Angela shell, procurement Division Chief.

- Submit report or an estimated date of completion to DGS by February 1, 2019.
- January 11th, 2nd email was sent addressing many questions regarding this request.
 - The original email request and two examples of this report were included.
 - ✓ Examples included DSG's and Caltrans use them as a guide to help craft your look-ahead report.
 - Format is at department discretion
 - Include brief description of upcoming large-scale procurements (IT or Non-IT goods/service).
 - Include estimated dollar value of each (if possible).
 - Include the anticipated date to be published/location (any information that may be helpful to the SB/DVBE community.
