SUBJECT: Target Area Contract Preference Act (TACPA) - Program Changes

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this communication is to announce an update to the State Contracting Manual (SCM), Volume 2 to incorporate a clarification resulting from recent legislation, AB 1574 (Statutes of 2021, Chapter 756), for the Target Area Contract Preference Act (TACPA) preference program.

#### Policy

The TACPA preferences apply to all competitive solicitations in excess of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the purchase of goods or services including information technology goods and services.

AB 1574 clarifies, for purposes of the TACPA, that the state is required to award both a workforce and a workplace preference for a contract for goods or services, as specified, if the bidder makes both of the required certifications. In addition, statutory language provides:

- 1. The maximum preference cost for the workplace preference cannot exceed \$50,000.00.
- 2. The maximum preference cost for the workforce preference cannot exceed \$50,000.00.
- 3. The maximum combined preferences and incentives resulting from a workplace preference, workforce preference, and other preferences or incentives provided under any other provision of law shall be 15% but may not in any case exceed \$100,000.00 in total.

### Background

Government. Code (GC) §§ 4530 – 4535.3 establishes and provides direction for the TACPA preference program. DGS implements the program through regulations and conveys instructions to state procurement professionals through the SCM.
