<u>CCDA Strategic Plan Goal</u>	<u>% Completion</u> (as of June 30, 2018)
1. Advocate for access curricula for all school programs.	20%
2. Increase disability access awareness.	80%
3. Create training programs for targeted constituencies. [aligned with 2018 DGS goal to conduct regional listening forums]	80%
4. Create and identify revenue streams to fund access needs (subject to increase CCDA staffing).	40%
5. Create financial and other incentives for access compliance.	40%
6. Explore the development of a state level Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Access office.	40%

<u>CCDA Strategic Plan Goal</u>	<u>% Completion</u> (as of June 30, 2018)
7. Advocate to hold authorities having jurisdiction accountable for the built environment (both public and private) to avoid passive non-compliance for architectural and program access.	80%
8. Maintain data on status of access compliance. [aligned with 2018 DGS goals to create electronic document management system and online database]	80%
9. Expand methods of identification, obligation, and enforcement of barrier removal in the built environment.	10%
